

Thambili House is today a haven of comfort, privacy and refinement for discriminating visitors. Set right next to the Fort Rampart, a few yards from old Famous Galle Fort Light House.



STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT FOR THIRD DAY, FRIDAY, 15TH APRIL, 2022

1.THE SPORTING TIMES CUP Class V / Horses rated 00 to 25 (about) 1070 M

Instructions to Jockey were recorded from trainer L.M. Prasanna Niroshan of his charge GO GREEN

As a special case on the request of trainer Jayantha and Jockey T. Pavithran was permitted to carry overweight of 3 kgs in respect of COSMOPOLITAN.

Trainer Raju Virupakshaiah and Jockey P. Dinesh were questioned regarding the running and riding of ZULU FANTASY. The trainer stated that he had instructed to jockey to after jumping out of the starting gates, to sit 4th along with the field and do his best in the straight and that being the first run of his charge he is quite satisfied with the riding of Jockey Dinesh, When questioned jockey Dinesh stated that he rode as per the instructions of the trainer, However quite noting their explanations jockey Dinesh was stated he must allow his mount to gallop freely and not break their stride in the initial stages of the race and to travel the shortest way possible rather ride its mount on the wider portion of the race track. He was further informed that being the first run of the gelding, their explanations were noted. The Club's veterinary officer reported that ZULU FANTASY was lame after the race. Trainer was informed to produce a Fitness Certificate before accepting with it again in a race.

Jockey T. Pavithran was severely reprimanded for permitting his mount to negotiate the bend very wide for no apparent reason, he was further advised that he should make every effort to traveled along the rails.

2.THE SPORTING STAR CUP Horses rated 22 to 45 (about) 1400 M.

Permission was granted to trainer Raju Virupakshaiah to withdraw GODSWORD (C. Umesh) on veterinary grounds. He was informed that he must produce a fitness certificate before accepting with it again in the races

Instruction to Jockey were recorded from trainer S.V. Mathialagan of his charge TORPEDO.

3.RTC MAYOR'S CUP Horses rated 45 to 65 (about) 1600 M

GLITTERING (L. Dayalan) planted in the starting gates and did not take practical part in the race, in view of its continued behavior, trainer Raju Virupakshaiah was informed not to accept with his charge, till such time its behavior improves to the satisfaction of the senior stipendiary steward.

Jockey Aneel, the rider of MYSTIC FLAME was questioned regarding easing of the mount in the final stages of the race where he lost the third position. The jockey stated that he mount was running under distress from the 200 metres of the race and if he had pushed his mount any further it would have broken down. The horse was checked immediately after the race and the club's veterinary officer reported that MYSTIC FLAME was lame. Trainer Raju Virupakshaiah was informed that he must produce a fitness certificate before accepting with it again in the races

Jockey V. Yograj the rider of ADMIRAL NELSON was cautioned for failing the follow the instructions imparted to him in riding of his mount ADMIRAL NELSON during the race. He was further informed that he should follow the given instructions and travel the shortest distance in the race and in that galloping on the outer portion of the race track will only put his mount at an disadvantageous position.

4.RTC GOVERNOR'S CUP Terms Race Horses rated 80 and above (about 1800 M)

As a special case on the request of trainer Sridher Selvaratnam and Jockey A. Imran Khan was permitted to carry overweight of 2 1/2 kgs in respect of WESTERN WIND.

Instructions to Jockeys were recorded from trainer Raju Virupakshaiah in respect of his charges viz.,MAURITANIA ,ROYAL CRYSTAL, SNOWDOWN & ALCAZABA.

Permission was granted to trainer S. V. Mathialagan to withdraw SPRITIED TOUCH (P.S. Kaviraj) on veterinary grounds. He was informed that he must produce a fitness certificate before accepting with it again in the races.

Jockey Aneel, the rider of ALCAZABA reported that after negotiating the bend into the home straight, he could not get a clear run hence he shifted on wide to make a clear run.

Jockey L. Dayalan the rider of MAURITANA was observed to have used his whip in excess of the permitted limits and improper manner. After due enquiry he pleaded guilty to a charge of excessive use of the whip on his mount during the race hence he has been fined Rs. 2000/- for excessive use of whip. He was further informed that he must desist from this improper of use of whip when he mount is clearly beaten even for minor placings and that not responding to the use of whip any more.

5.RTC QUEENS CUP

Terms race with penalties (about) 2000M

As a special case on the request of trainer Sridher Selvaratnam and Jockey A. Imran Khan was permitted to carry overweight of 1 1/2 kgs in respect of ANOTHER ACE.

HERE AND NOW (C. Umesh) was observed to be slow away from the starting gates, loosing sufficient grounds at the start, Jockey P.S. Kaviraj the rider of TUSCANO reported that his mount travelled on the outer portion of the race track inspite of his best efforts to ride him along the rails.

Jockey A, Imran Khan the rider of ANOTHER ACE reported that his mount was hanging out from the 250 metres of the race inspite of his best efforts to keep it on an even course, Trainer Sridher Selvaratnam was informed to take necessary corrections of his charge. Jockey A Imran Khan was further advised that he is permitted to use the whip in backhand or underhand manner in that he can only tap a horse on the shoulder provided the whip is held in a downward position and both the hand are on the reins and touching the horse's neck and any violations in the use of whip in future will be seriously viewed.


