Message from R. Manjunath Senior Stipendiary Steward


Horse Racing is one of the oldest of all sports and its basic concept has virtually not changed over the centuries. It has developed from a primitive contest of speed and stamina between two horse into a spectacle involving large number of horses, sophisticated electronic monitoring equipment's, online betting, and immense sums of money but its essential feature has always been the same, the horse that finishes first is the winner. In the modern era, horse racing developed from a diversion of leisure class into a huge public-entertainment business but it is really disheartening to see that this sport's popularity by the first decades of the 21st century shrinking considerably.

English racing spread very fast to many countries including Srilanka in the 19th century and many of their governing bodies emulated the British. The prestigious Governor's Cup, annual horse racing event was first held in Colombo in 1888, a distance of one mile was won by LADY DURHAMS carrying 9 stones 4 lbs ridden by Jockey Cavanagh and at Nuwara Eliya it was held in 1892 in a distance of five furlong was won by DUCHESS carrying 8 stones and 12 lbs ridden by Jockey Charlie. The Governor's cup is the most prestigious and important thoroughbred race of the year in Srilanka which is well organized by Royal Turf Club, Nuwara Eliya in the festival month of April. It is a weight for age race run over nine furlongs.

Added to The Governor's cup, the Queens Cup will also be run over a grueling distance of 2000 metres and expecting a good finish at the wining post. Both these races are just run after the Sinhalese New Year generally know as "Aluth Avurudda". The festival is the first signs of spring remind Srilankan's that its time for a spectrum of festivities. The town of Nuwara Eliya has a long history of celebrating the festival with grandeur lighting and all cultural, sporting activities come alive. Another major attraction at "Little England" is the exhibition held within the race course grounds. Various stall which sell items are put up including eatables and they attract a significant number of people from all over the Island. A play area containing attractions like a Ferris wheel is also present to provide entertainment to the people.



Horseracing was first introduced to Sri Lanka in the 1840's by Mr. John Baker, the brother of Samuel Baker, with the inaugural race taking place at the Nuwara Eliya Racecourse in 1875.



In 1910, in a meeting presided over by the Governor of Ceylon, Sir Henry Edward McCallum (1852–1919), it was resolved that the Colombo-based Ceylon Turf Club would be in a better position to manage the Nuwara Eliya course and the race meets, as it had greater financial clout, the ability to offer better prizes and was able to make improvements to the course and its buildings. The upper tiers of the modest but historic grandstand housed the race stewards, members and other assorted VIPs, giving them the best view over the course.

Horseracing in Sri Lanka peaked in the 1950s.



GENERAL:

1. Trainer Raju Virupakshiah was fined Rs. 2000/- for making errors in the entries, he was further fined a sum of Rs. 5000/- for failing to comply with the norms for declaration.

2. Trainer Prasanna was fined a sum of Rs 1000/- for failing to comply with the norms for declaration.

3. Trainers Mr S.V. Mathialagan, S.D. Mahesh and Jockeys P.S. Kaviraj and K. Sanjeevan was cautioned for inspecting the racing track on the morning of 5th April, 2022 without prior approval from the Clerk of the Course or any Official of the club.

RACING INCIDENTS:

1. THE BLACKPOOL HOTEL TROPHY Class 5 / Horses rated 00 to 25 (about) 1070M

Jockey S. Vijayanathan the rider of GO GREEN was fined Rs. 2000/- for coming in sharply approaching the 450 metres and negotiating the final bend thereby KRABI (Aneel) galloping on the inside had to be checked by its rider to avoid any interference.

2. THE ALPINE HOTEL TROPHY Class 4 / Horses rated 26 to 51 (about) 1070M

3. THE RTC MAGIC MILLION CUP. Terms race / for horses rated above 75 (about) 1600M

Jockey L Dayalan the rider of ROYAL CRYSTAL reported that he could not get a clear run approaching the 1400 metres due to crowding of the field, hence he had to shift on the outside for a clear run. Jockey C. Umesh was cautioned for failing the follow the instructions imparted to him in riding of his mount ALCAZABA during the race. He was further informed that he should follow the given instructions and report of any incidents during the race.

4. THE CHARIOT CUP Class 4 / Horses rated 26 to 51 (about) 1400M

Jockey L Dayalan, the rider of LEGENDARY PRINCESS was severely reprimanded for making a celebratory gesture before passing the winning post.

STAR SCHOLAR (K. Vivek) was observed to the running in distress and galloping detached from the field, in view of its poor performance trainer Mr Sridher Selvaratnam was informed not to accept with his charge in future, till such time its performance improves during the morning track work to the satisfaction of the stipendiary steward, However the trainer informed that he is retiring the gelding from racing.

5. THE ASRIEL CUP Class 3 / Horses rated 52 to 77 (about) 1400M

Jockey T. Pavithran the rider of VIGOROUS was fined Rs. 2000/- for permitting his mount to shift out approaching the 1300 and interfere with WESTERN WIND (A. Imran Khan) on his outside.

Jockey A, Imran Khan the rider of WESTERN WIND was fined total sum of Rs. 10.000/- for permitting his mount to shift in approaching the 1300 metres thereby causing severe interference to VIGOROUS (T. Pavitran) which was momentarily imbalanced and again for permitting his mount to shift in sharply approaching 1200 metres and again permitting his mount to shift out rounding the final bend and take out and cut across into the rightful running of SANTOS (Aneel) from the 300 metres till the winning post. After viewing CCTV footage of various angles of the race and taking evidence from jockeys T. Pavithran and Aneel, it was established Jockey A Imran Khan had made no attempt to take evasive action in correcting his mount when it had come across on an "acute angle" on both the occasions he had caused severe interferences and his failure to control his mount and make the proper effort to maintain a straight course. Jockey Aneel reported that the surcingle used on his mount snapped during the race.

The Club's Veterinary officer reported that SANTOS had lost its right for shoe during the race.

Jockey C. Umesh the rider of MYSTIC FLAME reported that the saddle used on his mount had slipped approaching the 1000 metres and hence he could not ride out his mount to his full potential. The saddle was immediately checked and trainer Raju Virupakshiah was cautioned for his lapse.


