Jockey Mohanraj was shown the film of the incident and severely reprimanded, he was informed that a repetition would lead to a suspension.

STORMY PETREL (S.Suganthan) ran wide making to 1100m turn. Trainer S.D. Lalith was fine SLRs 1,000 for presenting STOCK WELL in the enclosure with out a nose roll which was applied at the barriers.

Jockey Kishore Kadam was censured and told to keep his mount straighter in future.
