Judging by ticket sales we are expecting to see tourism inflow to Nuwara Eliya, increasing by at least a further 25% this year. We have also seen a huge increase in the Quantum and number of Sponsorships we have received this year and our Special Thanks goes to our Print Media Partner Wijaya Group and our Hospitality partner the latest Luxury sensation the Black Pool Hotel Nuwara Eliya.
