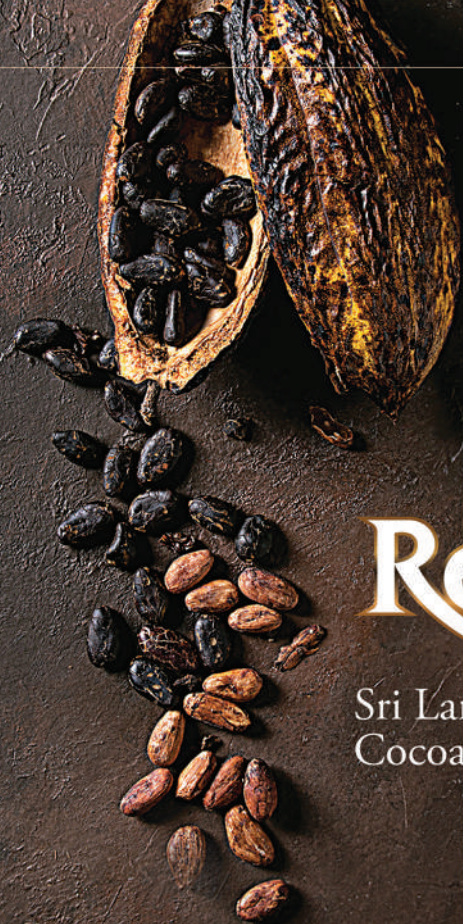

He was suspended from riding in races for 03 months and fined Rs 25,000.00 for Failing to ride to the satisfaction of the stewards. He has the rights of appeal against this decision to the stewards of the club within 72 hours stated there in the grounds for lodging such appeal.

02. On inquiry, Jockey M.Ishan (Vigorous) trainer Jayantha Weerasinghe had hedge a complaint that the jockey had not followed his instructions. After having heard jockey M.Ishan and trainer jayantha Weerasinghe and having viewed the video records of the race, The stipendiary stewards were not satisfied with the explanation tendered by jockey M. Ishan he pleaded guilty and he was suspended for 1 months in regard of both cases Jockey M.Ishan has been suspended for a period of 4 months. He has the rights of appeal against this decision within 72 hours stated there in the grounds for lodging such appeal against the decision of the stewards.

03. On inquiry, Jockey V.Yogaraj (Star Scholer) pleaded guilty to a charge under RTC rules for excessive use of whip He was fined the sum of RS 5,000.00. Jockey V.Yogaraj was everely reprimanded by the Stipendiary stewards.

04. On inquiry, trainer S.D.Mahesh (Glittering) and M.R.suresh (starter) in regard to the mare (Glittering) Mr .Suresh confirm to the stipendiary stewards at that time he gave the start all horses had a fair start the mare glittering stood in barrier and did not jump. The mare (Glittering) was not denied from the affair start. trainer SD mahesh agreed with both the stipendiary stewards and the starter that the mare (Glittering) will need to pass 2 barrier trials to satisfaction of the stipendiary stewards and the starter before being allowed to race again.

05. On inquiry, Trainer Sidher Selvaratnam (Knight of Key) pleaded guilty to the rules of RTC for not using the jockey colour which was printed on the race card. He failed into his responsibility as a license trainer to inform the stipendiary stewards. Trainer Selvaratnam apologies and confirm to stipendiary stewards that this incident will not happen in the future. He was severely reprimanded and fine Rs 5,000.00

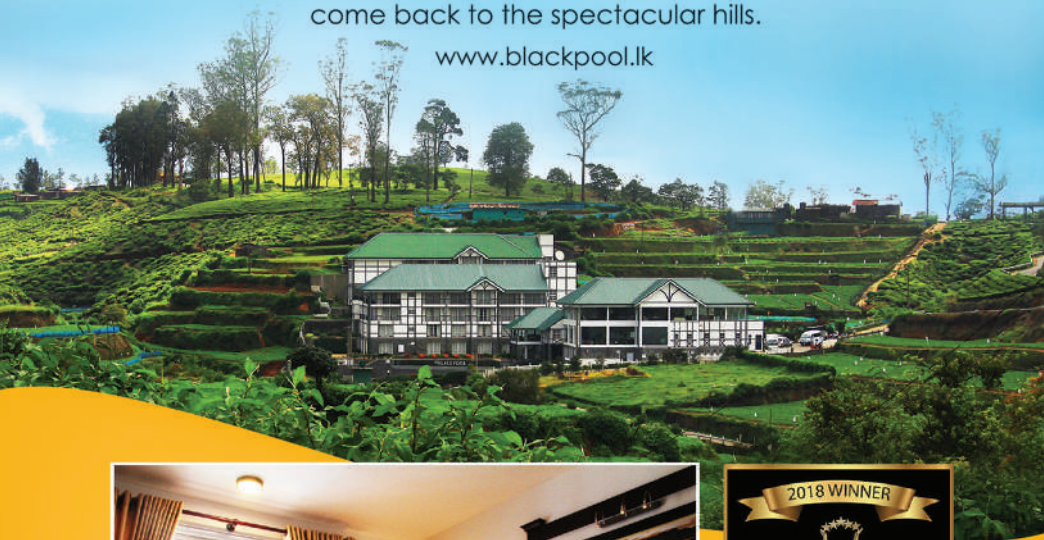
