**Stipendiary Stewards Incident Report Royal Turf Club inaugural race meeting on
Sunday 20th March 2016 on Nuwara Eliya racecourse**

Race 1 A HORIZONTAL URGE was withdrawn at 8-20am on Veterinary advice when it was found to be lame in the right fore. Trainer S.V.Madialagan was inform to have the mare passed before accepting with her again. The off side bandage on BEAUTIFUL LANKAN (Ashok Kumar) became detached near the 150m. Trainer S.D.Lalith was censured.

Race 2 Near the 600m KINGKOSMO (S.Niranjan) hung out covering extra ground. Mr A.V.K D'Silva was informed to rectify the trait in this horse prior to starting it again. Jockey R.Madhan Kumar (MILLENIUM BABY) was severely reprimanded for his excessive use of the whip. He was informed that should he offend again he will not be permitted to carry a whip.

Race 3 Specimens were taken from the winner SUPREME.
SUPREME was extremely fractious in the saddling area and was taken to the stables to be saddled. JOANNA (L.Dayalan) was slow to move when the gates were released.

Race 4 Specimens were taken from the winner GAZAKI.
ARRABIAN GOLD (S.D.Mahesh) dwelt at the start losing ground.

Race 5 This race was a walkover. Nothing to report

Race 6 Specimens were taken from the second placegetter ROSWALD. Trainer S.P.A. Raju was fined Rs3,000 for failing to obey the direction of an official in that he saddled CHARLATAN in the stables. FESTIVAL CITY (L.Dayalan) and MR MAJESTIC (N.S.Parmar) wer slow to move when the gates were released. Jockey S.D.Mahesh was admonished for excessive use of the whip on ROSWALD. Jockey S.D.Mahesh accidentally dropped his whip near the 80m. The Veterinarian reported that SPARK OF GOLD (S.Suganthan) had bled during the race. Trainer S.V.Madialagan was informed that the gelding can not race for 4 weeks.

Race 7 Jockey L.Dayalan, rider of REABATH, placed second lodged an objection against ARUNDATHI (M.Ishan) placed first alleging interference near the 100m. After hearing the evidence from both riders and from their own observations the objection was overruled. It was established that ARUNDATHI had shifted in near the 100m causing REABATH to be eased, however in the opinion of the Stewards this did not effect the result of the race. Jockey M.Ishan was told to exercise greater care in future.
