



Rashid Byramji was rightly considered the greatest Classic trainer his country has ever seen. He saddled a record 3,170 winners, including 230 Classics, across the country.


Byramji is the only professional to have achieved the rare feat of winning 10 Indian Derbies and 12 Indian Turf Invitation Cups.

Elusive Pimpernel raced and won at six different centres, winning 22 of his 23 starts.
